Brief Order of Confession and Forgiveness

P: We join in confessing our sin:

**C: Mighty God, we confess that at times we do not share in the joy of the resurrection but are caught up in the activities, demands and worries of this world. We confess that we do not always live as people claimed and saved by Jesus' great sacrifice but remain discontent, grumbling and anxious. Forgive us for taking the resurrection for granted and for not sharing the Good News. Forgive us when we find it more comfortable to worry and complain than to risk the joy and encouragement of new life in Christ. Call us back to Your ways, O God, to seek hope and reconciliation, restoration and peace. In the name of the Risen Christ, we pray. Amen.**

P: Christ is Risen! The stone is rolled away, the tomb found empty. Mary calls out, "I have seen the Lord!" We, too, have seen Christ alive and at work, and are called to new life, a life of forgiveness and reconciliation. Because of Jesus Christ's sacrifice and gift You are forgiven! In the name of Jesus, boldly live as resurrected people, claimed for life and forgiveness by Jesus Himself! He is Risen! Amen.
